The syllabus is poorly outlined and a lot of students were at a loss of what was expected of the course. Lengthy homework assignments were posted late and had to be completed in an unreasonable timeframe. I have emailed him asking for clarity regarding when assignments would be posted but he always responds with the fact he'll make an announcment soon. Quizzes were held before the homework was due which doesn't make sense and the course is incredibly fast paced.
